CCC Household Support Fund: Social Media Toolkit June 2022

Overview

In March the Government announced that councils would be provided with funding to continue operating the Household Support Fund because of the impact of the rising costs of living.

Cambridgeshire has been allocated £3.58million, of which £1.2m will be used to support households that include a person who has reached state pension age (66) by 30 September 2022 and are experiencing financial hardship.

Funding will also be used to continue providing food vouchers for eligible families with children and the Cambridgeshire Local Assistance Scheme which provides a safety net to individuals and families facing unexpected financial difficulties and hardship.

The main focus of the council's communications campaign is to encourage people of pensionable age who are in financial difficulty to seek help via the fund.
