Trained work and health coaches work with people to develop a personalised support plan that may including connecting with a range of local services. These could include

- Financial advice and debt management

- Housing advice
- Training and skill development
- Relationships and domestic abuse
- Home adaptations
- Carer support
- Substance misuse

- Young people not in education, employment or training
- Care leavers
